All applicants interested in a receiving a fellowship are requested to adhere to the following procedure:

1. Register for the e-course on the [UNITAR website](http://www.unitar.org/event/) (www.unitar.org/event/). For the time being, you can ignore the automated invoice you will receive to your e-mail.
2. Send an e-mail to page@unitar.org with the following information:
 - a. Your country of origin
 - b. Your current occupation
 - c. Fiscal policy-related activities or projects you are involved in
 - d. Your motivation for participating in the course
 - e. How you plan to use the acquired knowledge professionally
3. Please attach
 - a. CV
 - b. Copy of your passport (only participants from developing countries are eligible)

Fellowships will be allocated based on the criteria below:

- Merit of the application
- Potential use of knowledge in a professional setting
- Regional and gender balance

Kindly note that staff working in international organisations and the private sector are not eligible for a fellowship.

Deadline for submission of applications is **26 March 2018**.

Accepted applicants will be notified one week after the deadline.
