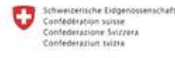

In recent years (2019–2024), the Partnership for Action on Green Economy (PAGE) Program in Argentina has brought together the efforts of five United Nations agencies (ILO, UNDP, UNEP, UNIDO, and UNITAR) to inspire and drive pathways toward a Green Economy in the country. It has developed industrial, labor, financial, and communication policy instruments that have successfully positioned these topics on the national and federal agenda.

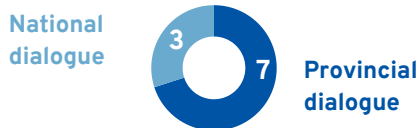
